

Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report – July 2020

Summary

- The COVID-19 pandemic continued to affect ridership
- The Blue/Green Line construction shutdown effective June 28, 2020 continued through July
- The suspension of the Trolley and Park-n-Ride services effective March 24, 2020 continued through July
- System ridership in July was 1.2 million, representing 53% fewer riders than in July 2019
 - o Average fixed route weekday was 54% lower¹
 - o Average fixed route Saturday was 51% lower¹
 - o Average fixed route Sunday was 51% lower¹
- Year-to-date ridership is 11.2 million, representing 39% fewer riders than through July 2019



Motorbus (MB)

Motorbus ridership in July 2020 was 51% lower than in July 2019

- Average weekday was 52% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 47% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 48% lower¹



Red Line (HR)

Red Line ridership in July 2020 was 52% lower than in July 2019

- Average weekday was 53% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 52% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 51% lower¹



Light Rail (LR)

Due to a Blue/Green Line construction shutdown, Light Rail ridership in July 2020 was 98% lower than in July 2019

- Average weekday was 98% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 97% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 97% lower¹



HealthLine (RB)

HealthLine ridership in July 2020 was 49% lower than in July 2019


- Average weekday was 49% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 56% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 50% lower¹




Paratransit (DR)

Paratransit ridership in July 2020 was 44% lower than in July 2019







System Ridership by Month
