




Economic Conditions – Northeast Ohio

Layoffs during COVID Pandemic 4 Findings from WARN Act Data





- 6-Week moving average of layoffs


Ridership









• <u>PPE</u> - Employees continue to prepare PPE kits to give away with the Need A Mask, Take A Mask program. The masks were donated from ODOT and FEMA.
