

Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report – September 2020

Summary

- The COVID-19 pandemic continued to affect ridership
- Sunday service replaced Weekday service for Monday, September 7, 2020 in observance of Labor Day
- System ridership in September was 1.3 million, representing 56% fewer riders than in September 2019
 - o Average fixed route weekday was 59% lower¹
 - Average fixed route Saturday was 46% lower¹
 - o Average fixed route Sunday was 49% lower¹
- Year-to-date ridership is 13.6 million, representing 43% fewer riders than through September 2019



Motorbus (MB)

Motorbus ridership in September 2020 was 55% lower than in September 2019

- Average weekday was 59% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 42% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 43% lower¹



Red Line (HR)

Red Line ridership in September 2020 was 57% lower than in September 2019

- Average weekday was 59% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 49% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 56% lower¹



<u>Light Rail (LR)</u>

Light Rail ridership in September 2020 was 69% lower than in September 2019

- Average weekday was 69% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 62% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 75% lower¹



HealthLine (RB)

HealthLine ridership in September 2020 was 54% lower than in September 2019


- Average weekday was 56% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 51% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 50% lower¹




Paratransit (DR)

Paratransit ridership in September 2020 was 39% lower than in September 2019


September 2020 System Ridership by Mode




System Ridership by Month
