

Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report – December 2020

Summary

- The COVID-19 pandemic continued to affect ridership
- Both rail transit modes experienced a significant drop in Sunday ridership due to limited attendance at Browns' home games during December 2020
- System ridership in December was 1.1 million, representing 55% fewer riders than in December 2019
 - o Average fixed route weekday was 57% lower1
 - o Average fixed route Saturday was 49% lower1
 - o Average fixed route Sunday was 51% lower¹
- Total annual ridership in CY 2020 was 16.9 million, representing 47% fewer riders than total annual ridership in CY 2019



Motorbus (MB)

Motorbus ridership in December 2020 was 53% lower than in December 2019

- Average weekday was 56% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 47% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 45% lower¹



Red Line (HR)

Red Line ridership in December 2020 was 60% lower than in December 2019

- Average weekday was 62% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 56% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 58% lower¹



Light Rail (LR)

Light Rail ridership in December 2020 was 66% lower than in December 2019

- Average weekday was 66% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 60% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 77% lower¹



HealthLine (RB)

HealthLine ridership in December 2020 was 50% lower than in December 2019


- Average weekday was 52% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 45% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 46% lower¹




Paratransit (DR)

Paratransit ridership in December 2020 was 42% lower than in December 2019







System Ridership by Month
