#### **MEETING NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given that the following meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority will take place on at <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>August 10</u>, <u>2021</u> in the Board Room of the Authority, 1240 West Sixth Street, Cleveland, OH 44113 for consideration of the listed items and such other items that may properly come before the Board and be acted upon.

This meeting will be live-streamed on RTA's Facebook page (<a href="www.facebook.com/rideRTA">www.facebook.com/rideRTA</a>) for staff and members of the public. Members of the public may also attend in-person. Based on Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidance to continue to avoid large events and gatherings and Ohio Department of Public Health advice that businesses and other entities may continue to require mitigation measures, as well as RTA's interest in protecting community and employee health and safety, the following measure will be in place for in-person attendance:

- To allow for social distancing, RTA Board Room capacity is limited to forty-four (44) people. To accommodate members of the public, RTA will limit the number of staff permitted in the Board Room.
- 2. All persons entering RTA's Main Office Building ("MOB") at 1240 West 6<sup>th</sup> Street are required to wear a mask/face covering and maintain a distance of six feet or more from other individuals who are not members of their family or household. The mask/face covering must be cloth or other fabric and worn to cover the person's nose, mouth and chin. If a person entering the building does not have a mask, one can be provided to them.

Engineering Services for Special Bridge Inspections

At the August 10, 2021 Operational Planning & Infrastructure Committee meeting, staff will present a Summary of the Proposed Award of Engineering Services for Special Bridge Inspections. These Special Bridge inspections are located throughout the GCRTA rail system.

This biennial project under Federal mandate includes hands-on inspection of the Steel Tension Non-redundant (STEN) bridge members that carry service loads. This 2021 project includes 44 structures that carry GCRTA revenue trains across the Red, Blue, Trunk Lines and one highway access bridge across Norfolk Southern west of the Central Rail Maintenance Facility.
