Architect/Engineer Services for E. 116th Station Design

- Serves Blue and Green Lines
- St. Luke's/E. 116th area being redeveloped with new library, school and housing options
- Existing station built in early 1980's and in need of replacement
- Design services from preliminary to plans thru construction assistance



Architect/Engineer Services for E. 116th Station Design

- New station will be ADA-compliant
- Covered stairs, platform canopies, precast platforms and new track
- Standardized signage, lighting and security systems
- Bicycle friendly



Architect/Engineer Services for E. 116th Station Design

- Construction budget \$3.5 million
- 360-day design schedule from NTP
- NEPA documentation by separate consultant
- Public art to be included
- Construction start planned Jan. 2016
- New station completion Sept. 2017

- Received by 28 Potential Vendors
- 4 Firms Submitted Proposals
- 3 Firms Shortlisted
