A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHOR-ITY WITH SUBURBAN SCHOOL BOARDS IN CUYAHOGA COUNTY RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION OF STUDENTS

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority to provide that the fare charged to students, residents of Cuyahoga County, who are on school related trips in school systems which avail themselves of the Ohio State or any other reimbursement program, during school hours, shall not exceed fifty (50%) percent of the fare charged to adult riders; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Transit Authority is willing to provide transportation to and from school and for school related trips for students of the various Suburban School Boards within the service area of the Regional Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, various Suburban School Boards have expressed a desire for such service and are willing to participate in the State School Transportation Program and to expend funds available for such service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio;

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby directed and authorized to enter into and execute Student Transportation Agreements with the various Suburban School Boards within the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority service area or with the authorized representative of the respective School Boards.

Section 2. That the Student Transportation Agreements shall be for the 1975-76 school year and shall reflect the RTA fare structure effective October 5, 1975.

Section 3. That said agreements shall provide for a payment of Ninety Dollars (\$90.00) for each student for whom the Suburban School Board is mandated to provide transportation under Chapter 3327 ORC and the Transportation Policy of the School Board.

Section 4. That said agreements shall provide for payment of Forty Five Dollars (\$45.00) per student eligible for reimbursement for transportation under the Transportation Policy of the Suburban School Board and the Rules of the State Board of Education.

Section 5. That said agreements shall provide for the Authority to furnish identification cards for all students in grades 9 through 12 and that it may provide them for students in grades "K" through 8 and that the Suburban School Boards." shall register all said students and make the certification required as to mileage.

Section 6. That the agreements shall contain a provision relative to the proration of payments effective October 5, 1975 and also the effect of student attendance factor.

Section 7. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
