

RESOLUTION NO. 1975-128

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY WITH SUBURBAN SCHOOL BOARDS IN CUYAHOGA COUNTY RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION OF STUDENTS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees acting by Resolution No. 1975-90, adopted October 14, 1975, authorized the General Manager to enter into and execute agreements with suburban school boards which agreements contained specific provisions enumerated in the resolution; and

WHEREAS, negotiations with suburban school boards have made it apparent that agreements will have to be modified and adapted to the particular circumstances of each school board; and

WHEREAS, the policy of the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority relating to the transportation of students is that student fares apply to all students in a school district which participates in the State of Ohio fare reimbursement program and which forwards State funds to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority recognizes that a school board utilizes various means for student transportation, including but not limited to "yellow school buses", contracts with private carriers and with individual parents, and that funds utilized for these services are obligations of the school boards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into and execute Student Transportation Agreements with the various Suburban School Boards within the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority service area or with the authorized representative of the respective School Boards.


Section 2. That consistent with obligations of the various Suburban School Boards, the Student Transportation Agreements shall provide for the maximum payment possible to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority of funds available through the State Board of Education.

Section 3. That said agreements shall recognize the alternate modes of student transportation furnished by the School Boards and allow adjustments to be made accordingly.

Section 4. That said agreements where possible shall be consistent with Resolution No. 1975-90.

Section 5. That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
