Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for services with Kenneth Roberts and Associates, Inc., to conduct a RUCUS Requirements Analysis for the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority.

Section 2. That said contract shall incorporate the terms and conditions contained in the proposal submitted by Kenneth Roberts and Associates, Inc., dated June 22, 1976.

Section 3. That said contract shall provide for the expenditure of funds not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00).
