

EXTENDING SENIOR CITIZENS' FARE PRIVILEGES TO
THOSE SENIOR CITIZENS IN ATTENDANCE AT THE
ANNUAL SENIOR CITIZENS COALITION MEETING ON
NOVEMBER 5, 1976

WHEREAS, the Senior Citizens Coalition will conduct its annual meeting and convention on November 5, 1976 on the campus of St. John's Cathedral; and

WHEREAS, due to the anticipated length of this meeting, those senior citizens in attendance may not be eligible for free transportation pursuant to their RTA Elderly Fare privileges; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees wishes to lend its aid and support to the members of the Senior Citizens Coalition;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 1. That between the hours of 4:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. on November 5, 1976, non-peak hour free transit privileges shall be extended to those senior citizens registered for the Authority's Elderly Fare privileges in attendance at the annual Senior Citizens Coalition.


Section 2. That special passes shall be distributed to those senior citizens who are registered for the Authority's Elderly Fare privileges in attendance at the Senior Citizens Coalition Meeting for the purpose of implementing said extension of fare privileges.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Trustees.
