

RESOLUTION NO. 1976-372

EXTENDING HOURS OF CRT OPERATION ON  
DECEMBER 20, 1976

WHEREAS, the 23rd Annual Shut-Ins-Party will be held December 20, 1976;  
and

WHEREAS, 400-500 shut-ins, handicapped, elderly, blind, and mentally  
retarded persons are invited by the Cleveland Jaycees to attend this party; and

WHEREAS, CRT vehicles and service would make it possible for many of  
these persons to attend the party; and

WHEREAS, present CRT service hours would have to be extended to accom-  
modate those persons attending this event; and

WHEREAS, carrying these persons will introduce many of them to CRT  
services and will have a positive promotional value for the CRT Program; and

WHEREAS, the promotional value enuring to the CRT Program shall be the  
consideration for the extension of the CRT hours.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the  
Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 1. That the hours of operation for CRT vehicles shall be extended  
on December 20, 1976, to allow for transportation of eligible persons to the Jaycee  
Christmas Shut-Ins-Party.

Section 2. That the extension of time shall be applicable only for those  
vehicles engaged in transporting patrons to this event.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its  
adoption.
