WHEREAS, Rapid Recovery by working with property owners, commercial and industrial managements and federal, state and local officials has provided imaginative foresight and leadership which has resulted in a cooperative voluntary effort which has already begun to affect a positive transformation of the properties along the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the general improvements and the artistic designs and graphics will enhance the aesthetic quality of the Rapid ride for the RTA patrons and will enhance the image of Cleveland and the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority;




