

RESOLUTION NO. 1977- 352

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS AND
EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS TO PROVIDE POLICE
TRAINING FOR THE AUTHORITY'S TRANSIT POLICE
BY THE CASE WESTERN RESERVE UNIVERSITY.

WHEREAS, Section 306.35 (Y) O. R. C., requires that the Authority's transit police complete specified police training; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires that its transit police force complete this course at the earliest possible date; and

WHEREAS, the Case Western Reserve University is willing to provide a special State certified training program commencing January 9, 1978, which will provide an early completion date as well as special transit related sessions;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute any and all necessary agreements with the Case Western Reserve University for the purpose of permitting the Authority's transit police to participate in the University's Certified Police Training Program, commencing January 9, 1978.

Section 2. That expenditures in the approximate amount of \$9500.00 are hereby authorized for participation in the abovementioned training program.

Section 3. That this resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
