A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH EAST PENN MANUFACTURING COMPANY, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF BUS BATTERIES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR. (Est. \$50,000.00 - General Income Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of East Penn Manufacturing Company, Inc. received on the 18th day of November, 1977 for the furnishing of bus batteries for a period of one (1) year, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total estimated expenditure of Fifty Thousand & 00/100 (\$50,000.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the President of the Board of Trustees is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Income Fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1977-67; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.
