

RESOLUTION NO. 1978-9

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MIDWEST AMERICAN SHELTER SYSTEMS FOR THE PURCHASE OF APPROXIMATELY 500 PASSENGER SHELTER STRUCTURES.  
(Est. \$1,000,000.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Midwest American Shelter Systems received on the 9th day of January, 1978 for the purchase of approximately 500 passenger shelter structures at the prices set forth in said bid, involving an estimated total expenditure of One Million & 00/100 (\$1,000,000.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% out of the UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1977-67; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
