

RESOLUTION NO. 1978 - 85

ESTABLISHING COMMUNITY RESPONSIVE TRANSIT  
SERVICE IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA OF THE CITY OF  
CLEVELAND.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater  
Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 1. That effective Monday, May 1, 1978, Community  
Responsive Transit (C.R.T.) service will be established in the  
"Downtown Area" of the City of Cleveland. The "Downtown Area"  
is defined as that area within the following geographical  
boundaries: On the north - Lake Erie; on the east - East 30th  
Street; on the south - Woodland Avenue, Lorain-Carnegie Bridge  
and Lorain Avenue; on the west - West 28th Street. "Closed door"  
service will be provided to the West 25th Street and Clark  
Avenue shopping area, and Metropolitan General Hospital.

Section 2. That the regular C.R.T. passenger eligibility  
requirements and regular C.R.T. fare structure will apply to  
this service.
