

RESOLUTION NO. 1978-88

AUTHORIZING AN EVALUATION FOR AND THE
SUBMISSION OF A BID TO THE MASSACHUSETTS
BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR THE
PURCHASE OF NOT MORE THAN TEN P.C.C.
CARS AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF
FUNDS NECESSARY FOR THE REQUIRED BID
DEPOSIT

WHEREAS, the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority is offering for sale by sealed bid 12 used P.C.C. cars in an "as is" and "where at" condition; and

WHEREAS, the ability of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority to meet the needs of its riders on an interim basis until the delivery of the currently on order new light rail vehicles may be enhanced by the acquisition of not more than ten of the cars offered for sale; and

WHEREAS, a sealed bid must be submitted in Boston, Massachusetts, before 2:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time April 25, 1978, which bid must include a ten (10%) percent bid deposit; and

WHEREAS, the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority is presently the only source of supply for said vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the bid proposal allows for inspection of the vehicles and requires an itemized bid per vehicle;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That an inspection and evaluation of the cars offered for sale be made by the Rail Equipment Staff of the Operations Division and, further, that a determination of the total cost of repair, shipping and any other operations necessary to provide fully operable cars in Cleveland, Ohio, be and is hereby authorized.

Section 2. That the submission of a bid specifying an amount for each individual vehicle be and it is hereby authorized providing that the bid price per vehicle shall be the net estimated value after subtracting the estimated total cost for repairs, shipping and any other preparations necessary to make the car fully operational in Cleveland, Ohio.

Section 3. That the expenditure of ten (10%) percent of the total bid price as determined by the evaluation made by Rail Equipment Staff be and it is hereby authorized.

Section 4. That the ultimate purchase of said vehicles and the authorization of the necessary funds to accomplish the purchase if the bid submitted is successful shall be subject to Board approval.

Section 5. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
