## RESOLUTION NO. 1978 - 179

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES WITH HEERY ASSOCIATES, INC., RAMCO DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, AND URS/MADIGAN-PRAEGER, INC., A JOINT VENTURE FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,962,479.00.

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority selected Heery Associates, Inc., Ramco Development Company, and URS/Madigan-Praeger, Inc., a joint venture as the construction manager for capital projects under OH-03-0054 by Resolution No. 1978-5 adopted January 10, 1978; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Heery Associates, Inc., Ramco Development Company, and URS/Madigan-Praeger, Inc., a joint venture, which has been negotiated in conformance with Resolution No. 1978-5 provides for the expenditure of funds in the amount of \$2,962,479.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

- Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Heery Associates, Inc., Ramco Development Company, and URS/Madigan-Praeger, a joint venture, for construction management services as will be required by Capital Grant OH-03-0054.
- Section 2. That said contract shall be consistent with the proposal submitted September 19, 1977, and shall be subject to UMTA approval.
- Section 3. That the expenditure of not to exceed \$592,496.00 be and it is hereby authorized as the local matching share for the construction management services.
- Section 4. That the funds for the construction management services shall be allocated on an 80% federal-20% local basis as part of OH-03-0054 and shall be subject to the rules and regulations of UMTA.
- Section 5. That said contract shall provide for the expenditure of funds not to exceed \$592,496.00 GCRTA funds and \$2,369,983 UMTA funds.
- Section 6. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Request for Proposal; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 1977-67; insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.
- Section 7. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
