

RESOLUTION NO. 1978-186

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE PENETRYN SYSTEM, INC. FOR BRIDGE REPAIRS OVER RAPID TRANSIT TRACKS.

(\$28,400.00 - General Income Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of The Penetryn System, Inc. received on the 9th day of June, 1978 for bridge repairs over rapid transit tracks, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Twenty-eight Thousand Four Hundred & 00/100 (\$28,400.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contract to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1977-67; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Income Fund.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
