

RESOLUTION NO. 1978-306

AUTHORIZING A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TO  
DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF RELOCATING  
THE EAST 120th STREET RAPID TRANSIT STATION

WHEREAS, relocation of the East 120th Street Rapid Transit Station may permit greater convenience to riders and increase ridership by providing better bus access and limited parking facilities; and

WHEREAS, a study is necessary to determine the feasibility of such relocation; and

WHEREAS, funding in an amount not to exceed \$40,000,00 for developing the feasibility study has been provided by the Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) on an 80-20 basis under Section 9, as part of the previously approved Fiscal Year 1979 Overall Work Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That Requests for Proposals for determining the feasibility of relocating the East 120th Street Rapid Transit Station be and they are hereby authorized.

Section 2. That said Requests for Proposals shall contain a requirement that the contractor shall comply with the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees September 5, 1978, Resolution No. 1978-252.

Section 3. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Trustees.
