

RESOLUTION NO. 1979-3

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ABLE FENCE & GUARD RAIL FOR THE FURNISHING, FABRICATION & INSTALLATION OF SECURITY FENCING.
(\$239,223.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Able Fence and Guard Rail received on the 7th day of December, 1978 for the furnishing, fabrication and installation of security fencing, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Two Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Three & 00/100 Dollars (\$239,223.00), be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, meeting specifications, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
