

RESOLUTION NO. 1979-10

AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF THE PUBLIC
TRANSPORTATION OPERATING AGREEMENTS
WITH THE CITIES OF MAPLE HEIGHTS AND
NORTH OLMSTED FOR A PERIOD OF SIXTY DAYS.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Motion extended for ninety (90) days the Operating Agreements with the Cities of Maple Heights, North Olmsted and Euclid on October 2, 1978; and

WHEREAS, an agreement for acquisition of the transit facilities of the City of Euclid has been accomplished; and

WHEREAS, negotiations are continuing between the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority and the Cities of Maple Heights and North Olmsted, but require additional time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Public Transportation Operating Agreements between the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority and the Cities of Maple Heights and North Olmsted previously extended for ninety (90) days be and they are hereby extended for sixty (60) days to afford all parties to the negotiations an opportunity to reach agreement.

Section 2. That all terms and conditions of the Agreements shall remain in full force and effect for sixty (60) days from January 5, 1979.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
