

RESOLUTION NO. 1979-13

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH STORER BROADCASTING COMPANY FOR RADIO TRANSMITTER FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Authority's existing lease of space for radio transmitter facilities with Storer Broadcasting Company, originally authorized by Resolution No. 124-71 of the Transit Board of the City of Cleveland, will terminate on December 31, 1978; and

WHEREAS, the Authority requires these facilities in order to maintain its communication system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be, and hereby is, authorized to enter into an agreement with Storer Broadcasting Company for the lease of control board space, transmitter equipment space and permission to place radio antennae upon Storer Broadcasting Company's transmitter facility located at Pleasant Valley Road and State Road.

Section 2. That the term of said lease agreement shall be one year, with an option to extend the lease of transmitter equipment space and radio antennae placement space for an additional two years thereafter.

Section 3. That an annual rental cost in an amount not to exceed twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000.00) is hereby authorized.

Section 4. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Trustees.
