

RESOLUTION NO. 1979 - 14

AUTHORIZING A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FROM
CONSULTANTS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SIMS
(SERVICE, INVENTORY, MAINTENANCE) SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees Resolution No. 1977-330 authorized a request for proposals and expenditure of funds for conduct of a study to determine the feasibility of implementing the SIMS (Service, Inventory, Maintenance) System; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees Resolution No. 1978-119 authorized the General Manager to enter into a contract for services with Kenneth A. Roberts & Associates to conduct said study; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary findings of the study indicate that the system, if implemented, can produce substantial benefits to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has determined that professional consulting assistance is needed in order to implement the system; and

WHEREAS, Capital Grant OH-03-0059, authorized by Resolution No. 1977-154 which has been approved by the Department of Transportation, will provide 80% of the funding for the contract for said services;

NOW, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is authorized to prepare and distribute to interested consultants a request for proposals for implementation of the SIMS (Service, Inventory, Maintenance) System.

Section 2. That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
