

RESOLUTION NO. 1979-25

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH GENERAL RAILWAY SIGNAL COMPANY FOR FURNISHING AND INSTALLING SIGNAL EQUIPMENT AT TWO TRACK CROSSOVERS.
(\$719,272.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of General Railway Signal Company received on the 28th day of December, 1978 for furnishing and installing signal equipment at two track crossovers, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Seven Hundred Nineteen Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-two & 00/100 (\$719,272.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% out of the UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
