

RESOLUTION NO. 1979-62

AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF THE PUBLIC
TRANSPORTATION OPERATING AGREEMENTS
WITH THE CITIES OF MAPLE HEIGHTS AND
NORTH OLMSTED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR
UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees extended the Operating Agreements with the Cities of Maple Heights and North Olmsted for ninety (90) days on October 2, 1978 and for an additional sixty (60) days on January 2, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees adopted a Motion at a Special Meeting March 1, 1979 extending the Operating Agreements with the two cities for a period of one year from March 5, 1979 subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, said Motion was directed to be formalized in a Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:


Section 1. That the Public Transportation Operating Agreements between the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority and the Cities of Maple Heights and North Olmsted previously extended for 150 days be and they are hereby extended for a period of one year to expire March 5, 1980 subject to the following conditions:

- A. That within ninety (90) days of March 5, 1979 the cities of Maple Heights and North Olmsted demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Board of Trustees that they are in compliance with the Public Transportation Operating Agreements, particularly Section 15.
- B. That the respective cities and the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority discuss and agree upon terms for an ultimate acquisition of each of the cities' transit systems by the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority.
- C. That all disputes not resolved within the ninety (90) day period will be submitted to a court of competent jurisdiction for a Declaratory Judgment.

Section 2. That this Resolution confirms the Motion passed by the Board of Trustees on March 1, 1979.

Section 3. That this Resolution is effective immediately upon its adoption.
