A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH DUNCAN INDUSTRIES FOR THE FURNISHING OF SIXTY-SEVEN (67) FAREBOXES (\$51,054.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined that the within commodity is non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than Duncan Industries.

Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Duncan Industries for the furnishing of sixtyseven (67) fareboxes, involving a total expenditure of Fifty One Thousand Fifty Four Dollars & 00/100 (\$51,054.00).

Section 3. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
