

RESOLUTION NO. 1979- 198

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE  
PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
TO ENTER INTO THE RENEWAL OF A  
LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH STANDARD  
OIL COMPANY FOR PROPERTY LOCATED  
AT PLEASANT VALLEY AND STATE ROADS

WHEREAS, a license agreement between the Authority and the Standard Oil Company (SOHIO), authorized by Resolution No. 302-74, adopted May 2, 1974, permitted the Authority to use a portion of Sohio's property located at Pleasant Valley and State Roads for bus terminal purposes; and

WHEREAS, said license agreement has expired; and

WHEREAS, the Authority still requires the use of these premises for bus operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the President of the Board of Trustees be and is hereby authorized to execute a license agreement with the Standard Oil Company, an Ohio Corporation, for the use of the following described premises:

" frontage 40 feet on the west side of State Road, 182 feet along the north line (being the south line of an 8 foot strip of which Standard Oil Company granted an easement to the Ohio Fuel Gas Company), 110 feet on the west property line and an irregular south line of 115 feet and 80 feet "

Section 2. That the term of the license agreement shall be five (5) years.

Section 3. The annual consideration for license agreement shall be \$600.00.

Section 4. The license agreement shall be subject to sixty (60) day cancellation notice by either party.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
