

RESOLUTION NO. 1979- 219

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH YELLOW CAB COMPANY OF CLEVELAND, INC. FOR SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICE SUPPORTING THE COMMUNITY RESPONSIVE TRANSIT PROGRAM FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS.
(\$400,000.00 est. average annually - General Income Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Yellow Cab Company of Cleveland, Inc. received on the 9th day of July, 1979 for special transportation service supporting the community responsive transit program, for a period of three (3) years, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total estimated average annual expenditure of Four Hundred Thousand & 00/100 (\$400,000.00) Dollars, based on current levels of service, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Income Fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
