

RESOLUTION NO. 1979- 223

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SEAWAY PUBLIC CLEANING SERVICE FOR THE CLEANING OF PASSENGER SHELTERS AND COMFORT STATIONS FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR.
(\$29,704.00 - General Income Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Seaway Public Cleaning Service received on the 6th day of July, 1979 for the cleaning of passenger shelters and comfort stations at the price set forth in said bid, for a period of one (1) year, involving a total expenditure of Twenty-nine Thousand Seven Hundred Four & 00/100 (\$29,704.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Income Fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
