NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County:

Section 1. That the most sincere appreciation of the Board of Trustees is hereby extended to Carole F. Hoover for her continuing diligent efforts, leadership and initiative, especially in Minority affairs.
