

RESOLUTION NO. 1979-296

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ERNEST F. DONLEY'S
SONS, INC. FOR RETAINING WALL CONSTRUCTION FOR LIGHT RAIL
SYSTEM RIGHT-OF-WAY IMPROVEMENTS.
(\$405,000.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Ernest F. Donley's Sons, Inc., received
on the 23rd day of October, 1979, for retaining wall construction for light
rail system right-of-way improvements in the amount of Four Hundred Five Thousand
and 00/100 Dollars (\$405,000.00), be and the same is hereby approved as the
lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is
hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing
of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of
80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obliga-
tion of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid
Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the
Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and
all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
