BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of The Marshall Motor Company received on the 5th day of November, 1979 for the furnishing of nine (9) transit police automobiles, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Sixty-three Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-nine & 29/100 (\$63,439.29) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.
