

RESOLUTION NO. 1980-14

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH B & B WRECKING FOR MISCELLANEOUS RETAINING WALLS AND DRAINAGE FOR THE LIGHT RAIL SYSTEM RIGHT-OF-WAY IMPROVEMENTS, PROJECT NO. 1, BID PACKAGE C.
(\$487,236.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of B & B Wrecking received on the 8th day of January, 1980 for miscellaneous retaining walls and drainage for the light rail system right-of-way improvements in the amount of Four Hundred Eighty-seven Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-six & 00/100 (\$487,236.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.


Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
