

RESOLUTION NO. 1980- 42

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ALLEGHENY DROP
FORGE COMPANY FOR FURNISHING AND DELIVERING BONDED IN-
SULATED JOINTS
(Est. \$172,500 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of the Allegheny Drop Forge Company re-
ceived on the 23rd day of January, 1980 for furnishing and delivering bonded
insulated joint items at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total
estimated expenditure of One Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Five Hundred & 00/100
(\$172,500) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best
responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of
80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obliga-
tion of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid
Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the
Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and
all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
