A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ANACONDA INDUSTRIES, WIRE AND CABLE DIVISION FOR FURNISHING AND DELIVERING CATENARY MATERIALS, ITEMS NO. 1,2,3,4,11, and 12. (Est. \$1,520,000.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Anaconda Industries, Wire and Cable Division received on the 23rd day of January, 1980 for furnishing and delivering catenary materials, Items 1,2,3,4,11, and 12 at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total extimated expenditure of One Million Five Hundred Twenty Thousand and 00/100 (\$1,520,000.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.
