AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO EXTEND FOR ONE YEAR A CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH MAINSTEM CORPORATION TO CONTINUE OPERATION OF A VEHICLE MAINTENANCE DATA COLLECTION AND REPORTING SYSTEM FOR THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, the services offered by Mainstem Corporation have been found suitable to the requirements of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority for a vehicle maintenance data collection and reporting system; and

WHEREAS, the "Mainstem" system of data collection and reporting has become an important source of bus maintenance information for use by the Equipment Department of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority in measuring productivity, anticipating maintenance requirements, identifying areas requiring further training for mechanics, identifying supervisory costs, identifying requirements for parts and components, and providing detailed maintenance cost reports; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has taken steps to design and implement an internally operated Service Inventory and Maintenance System (SIMS) using a program developed by the Urban Mass Transportation Administration, but such a system will not be ready to furnish vital maintenance management information until late 1980.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby directed and authorized to extend for one year the personal service contract with Mainstem Corporation to continue operation of a vehicle maintenance data collection and reporting system for the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority.

Section 2. That said personal service contract shall incorporate the terms and conditions contained in the proposal from Mainstem Corporation relating to vehicle maintenance data collection and reporting system.

Section 3. That the fee for said services shall be \$4,178 per month, plus supplies and shipping costs not to exceed an additional \$836 per month, for a maximum charge of \$5,014 per month.

Section 4. That the service may be cancelled after six (6) reporting periods upon written notification by either party at least 90 days in advance of the cancellation.

Section 5. That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
