A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH LORAM CONSTRUCTION INC. FOR TRACKWORK AND CATENARY, PROJECT NO. 6, BID PACKAGE A, RECONSTRUCTION OF LIGHT RAIL SYSTEM. (\$18,861,406.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Loram Construction Inc. received on the 14th day of March, 1980 for trackwork and catenary, project No. 6, bid package A, reconstruction of light rail system, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Eighteen Million Eight Hundred Sixty-one Thousand Four Hundred Six & 00/100 (\$18,861,406.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract should reflect the deletion of the cash allowance for flagman services in the amount of \$500,000.00.

Section 3. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 4. That said contract shall be subject to UMTA concurrence.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
