

RESOLUTION NO. 1980 - 152

AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$57,000
FOR EMPLOYEE INCENTIVE PROGRAMS DURING THE YEAR 1980
FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL
TRANSIT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has recognized a need to enhance employee development, employee performance, and to promote employee safety-consciousness; and

WHEREAS, seven programs have been developed for that purpose,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That an expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$57,000 be and it is hereby authorized for the implementation of the seven programs listed below for 1980:

1. PERFORMANCE AWARDS	\$22,000.00
2. BUS ROADEO SAFETY PROGRAM	6,000.00
3. DISTRICT AND SHOP AWARDS FOR ACCIDENT REDUCTION	15,000.00
4. SAFETY COMMITTEE PROGRAM	2,000.00
5. RETIREES RECOGNITION NIGHT	2,500.00
6. SUPERVISORY SKILLS AND MANAGEMENT DEVELOPMENT	4,500.00
7. SAFETY PATCH PROGRAM	5,000.00


Section 2. That the expenditure of funds for each program shall be subject to review and approval by the General Manager and the Secretary-Treasurer.
