A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BETHLEHEM STEEL CORPORATION FOR FURNISHING AND DELIVERING RESTRAINING RAIL COMPONENTS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Bethlehem Steel Corporation received on the 21st day of March, 1980 for furnishing and delivering restraining rail components, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total estimated expenditure of Three Hundred Eleven Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-five & 00/100 (\$311,995.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.
