

RESOLUTION NO. 1980-181

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA, INC.
FOR FURNISHING OF PERSONAL HAND-HELD TWO-WAY F.M. RADIOS
AND ASSOCIATE EQUIPMENT.
(\$93,966.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Motorola, Inc. received on the 9th day
of April, 1980 for the furnishing of personal hand-held two-way F.M. radios and
associate equipment, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total
expenditure of Ninety-three Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-six & 00/100
(\$93,966.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best
responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said items.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of
80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obli-
gation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the
Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted
by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance require-
ments and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the
Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
