

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH VALLEY FORD TRUCK SALES, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF FOUR (4) DUMP TRUCKS WITH SNOW PLOWS AND SALT SPREADERS.
(\$111,633.20 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Valley Ford Truck Sales, Inc. received on the 16th day of April, 1980 for the furnishing of four (4) dump trucks with snow plows and salt spreaders, at the prices set forth in said bid, including additional option, involving a total expenditure of One Hundred Eleven Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-three & 20/100 (\$111,633.20) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
