

RESOLUTION NO. 1980- 222

AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF SUNDAY PASS
FARE PRIVILEGES ON SATURDAY, JUNE 28, 1980,
IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CELEBRATION OF
THE FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE TERMINAL
TOWER

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, acting through Resolution No. 1979-134 of May 22, 1979, authorized fare privileges for purchasers of Sunday Passes; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, June 28, 1980, Cleveland will celebrate the fiftieth anniversary of the opening of its major landmark, the Terminal Tower; and

WHEREAS, since its construction, the Terminal Tower has been Cleveland's transportation center, and to this day is vital to RTA's operations; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has been requested by the City of Cleveland, through its mayor, George Voinovich, to lend its support to this once-in-a-lifetime celebration by offering special fares on June 28 to help Cleveland's residents join in this civic function; and

WHEREAS, although the Board of Trustees has maintained a longstanding policy against special fare requests, it has chosen to honor the Mayor's request on this unique occasion only;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That Sunday Pass fare privileges, which permit up to four persons (two adults over the age of eighteen and two minors) to ride all Regional Transit Authority lines for seventy-five cents, or with a valid Weekly or Monthly pass shall apply on Saturday, June 28, 1980, only, for the purpose of assisting in the celebration of the fiftieth anniversary of the Terminal Tower.

Section 2. That the Board's policy of not honoring special fare requests is not altered by adoption hereof.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
