A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ANTHONY ALLEGA CEMENT CONTRACTOR, INC. FOR THE INSTALLATION OF CONCRETE PAVEMENT AT BUS LAYOVERS AT GARFIELD MALL AND SHOREGATE MALL (\$8,745.00 - GENERAL INCOME FUND)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1.
