A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF PARTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, FROM GENERAL RAILWAY SIGNAL COMPANY, AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR. (Est. \$15,000.00 - General Income Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined that the within commodity is non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than the General Railway Signal Company.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the General Railway Signal Company for the purchase of parts for signal equipment, as required, for a period of one (1) year, beginning September 1, 1980, involving an estimated expenditure of \$15,000.00 payable out of the General Income Fund.

Section 3. That all purchase orders issued by the Department of Procurement involving expenditures in excess of \$2,500.00 each shall be first approved by the General Manager of the Authority.

Section 4. Prices to be paid for said material ordered shall be at the prices offered by the General Railway Signal Company at the time of placement of each order.

Section 5. That said contract shall be subject to the nondiscriminatory clause.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
