A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH U.S. STEEL SUPPLY COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING AND INSTALLING OF CHAIN LINK FENCE AT BROOKLYN STATION PARKING LOT. (\$29,295.00 - General Income Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of U. S. Steel Supply Company received on the 30th day of July, 1980 for the furnishing and installing of chain link fence at Brooklyn Station parking lot, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Twenty-nine Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-five and 00/100 (\$29,295.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Income Fund.

Section 3.
