

RESOLUTION NO. 1980-327

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING THE
GENERAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN EMERGENCY
CONTRACT WITH THE KERITE CABLE COMPANY FOR
THE FURNISHING OF SIGNAL CABLE
(ESTIMATED \$30,000.00 - GENERAL FUND)

WHEREAS, as a result of lightning damage on September 13, 1980,
approximately 13,000 feet of signal cable was destroyed; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of said cable seriously depleted the
stock of said cable; and

WHEREAS, the lack of adequate stock of signal cable has created a
real and present emergency in the operation of the rail system of the
Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the
Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That by virtue of the lack of adequate stock of signal
cable a real and present emergency exists.

Section 2. That, due to the existing emergency, the General Manager
be, and is hereby authorized to enter into an emergency contract with the
Kerite Cable Company for the furnishing of signal cable with an estimated
expenditure of \$30,000.00 payable out of the General Fund.

Section 3. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its
adoption by the Board of Trustees.
