

RESOLUTION NO. 1981-36

AUTHORIZING A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF MAINTENANCE OPERATIONAL PERFORMANCE STANDARDS FOR BUS SHOPS AND GARAGES

WHEREAS, the implementation of maintenance operational performance standards will promote increased availability of buses; and

WHEREAS, the development of maintenance operational performance standards requires participation from all levels of RTA management and supervision responsible for the maintenance of buses; and

WHEREAS, funding in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00 for developing the operational performance standards has been provided by the Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) on an 80-20 basis under Section 9, as part of the previously approved Fiscal Year 1981 Overall Work Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That Requests for Proposals for the development of maintenance operational standards for bus shops and garages be and are hereby authorized.

Section 2. That said Requests for Proposals shall contain a requirement that the contractor shall comply with the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees September 5, 1978, Resolution No. 1978-252.

Section 3. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Trustees.
