

RESOLUTION NO. 1981-120

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER  
TO ENTER INTO AN EMERGENCY CONTRACT WITH THE GENERAL RAILWAY  
SIGNAL COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF TRAIN STOPS  
(Est. \$81,000.00 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, on April 21, 1981 sixteen train stops on the Authority's  
Red Line were damaged beyond repair; and

WHEREAS, these train stops are an integral part of the Red Line  
signal system; and

WHEREAS, as the General Railway Signal Company is the only source  
of supply of compatible replacements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the  
Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That as a result of the damage to train stops  
a real and present emergency exists.

Section 2. That due to the existing emergency, the General  
Manager be and is hereby authorized to enter into an emergency contract  
with the General Railway Signal Company for the furnishing of train stops,  
with an estimated expenditure of Eighty-one Thousand & 00/100 (\$81,000.00)  
Dollars payable out of the General Fund.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immed-  
iately upon its adoption.
