

RESOLUTION NO. 1981-133

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH PORTEC, INC., RMC DIVISION FOR THE FURNISHING OF ONE (1) RAIL SPIKE DRIVER, INCLUDING ADDITIONAL OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT. (\$70,475.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062) (80% UMTA, 20% Local Funding)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Portec, Inc., RMC Division, received on the 24th day of April, 1981 for the furnishing of one (1) rail spike driver, including additional optional equipment, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Seventy Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-five & 00/100 (\$70,475.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
